Our Mission

The purpose of the ASM is to develop and support the conduct of programs that promote, create, preserve, and maintain for charitable, scientific, and/or educational purposes, space-related artifacts and interpretive/instructional programs, to

recognize and memorialize the American spaceflight workforce. To fulfill this mission, the ASM operates a 2,800 sq. ft. museum in downtown Titusville, which is open to the public, Monday through Saturday, and assists the City of Titusville in caring for the Space Walk of Fame, a multi-block tribute to the American space industry through plaques and statues.



Our Goals

To provide a forum for qualified individuals to acquire, review, evaluate, and determine the suitability of space artifacts for incorporation into a museum-quality collection, worthy of public support, as displays and recognitions.

To develop displays and demonstrations of hardware, software, documents, and artistic renditions that describe, depict, and explain elements of any and all aspects of aerospace technology – past, present, and future – for the purpose of informing and engaging the general public in space-related activities.

To implement and maintain a historical preservation program for the benefit of ASM members and the general public.

To assist in the education of future space scientists, engineers, and technicians via programs in space-related science, technology, engineering, art, and mathematics (STEM).

To provide a forum for the dissemination of information on matters of interest about the space community to ASM members and the public.

To offer formal and informal networking opportunities and social events, for the purpose of promoting contact with individuals interested in furthering the mission of the museum.

To promote the Space Walk of Fame in downtown Titusville and assist in preserving the monuments on display therein.

Friends of the ASM

Those enrolling as a **Sustaining** or **Stellar** member will receive the title of “**Friend of the ASM,**” entitling them to special recognition at select ASM events, such as the following:

- **The ASM Space Memorabilia Show**

This event typically takes place twice a year, and features displays and artifacts on NASA’s impact on space exploration, particularly from the early un-manned launches to the Mercury, Gemini, Apollo missions, to the Space Shuttle era and the International Space Station (ISS). Featuring vendors showcasing space-influenced artwork and craft items, visitors can purchase astronaut autographs, NASA clothing items, and see unique photographs from mankind’s early years of space exploration.

- **ShuttleFest**

This summertime event, generally held around mid-June, brings together NASA and aerospace contractor alumni and space enthusiasts for presentations and discussions on the NASA’s Space Shuttle program, which existed from the late 1970s until the final flight of the Space Shuttle Atlantis in 2011. Attended by several hundred people, this event is ASM’s premiere offering to the aerospace community and features an astronaut “Meet & Greet” and book signings of works recently published on space exploration.

- **Charity Auctions and Appraisals**

Conducted by Chuck Jeffrey of *Bid Again Auctions*, these events – generally held four to five times each year – give space enthusiasts and collectors a chance to purchase unique items and artifacts from the space industry.

- **Appraisals of Space Memorabilia**

Most space memorabilia have value – even manuals, visitor passes, posters, photos, and other items that may seem, at first glance, throwaway items. Partnering with *Bid Again Auctions*, experts on space memorabilia can appraise space collectibles, and help sell such items, if so desired.

In addition, a **Stellar** membership entitles the individual to participate in these unique opportunities:

- **Appearance on *Stay Curious* Podcast**

Stellar members are invited to appear on the museum’s *Stay Curious* podcast, a daily space program (on air Monday through Friday), that now has over 14,000 viewers on YouTube.

- **Podium Opportunity**

Stellar members will be given a chance to address the audience at an ASM Memorabilia Show or at ShuttleFest, either before or after a panel discussion or speaker presentation.
